The following is from the New York Times, by Michael deCourcy Hinds. It hit the front page of today's Seattle Post-Intelligencer.

All the members of the arson team were recommended by the federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, which planned and executed the initial raid in the compound. ...

(Paul) Gray (head of the arson team) has close ties to the ATF. Now assistant chief of the Houston Fire Department Arson Bureau, Gray said he is on the ATF's National Arson Response Team, and in the 1980s he taught courses on arson to agents. His wife, Donna, is a secretary in the agency's Houston office.

In addition, the three other members of Gray's arson team were recommended by the ATF to the U.S. attorneys office in Waco, which selected the team.
