Seven Principles of Legislation Formulated by Sam Aurelius Milam III

Just because a thing is bad, that doesn't necessarily mean that the thing should also be prohibited.

Just because a thing is good, that doesn't necessarily mean that the thing should also be required.

Just because a thing is dangerous, that doesn't necessarily mean that the thing should also be regulated or restricted.

If it isn't necessary to enact legislation, then it is necessary to not enact legislation.

Legislation should apply first to the legislators. If they haven't repealed it after a trial period, then it can apply to the people.

Legislation should be automatically rescinded if a majority of the people disregard it.

Legislation should universally and automatically expire twelve months after its enactment.
